Thank you for applying to become a Member of this prestigious Club where you can enjoy a drink or two in comfortable surroundings (our bar prices are very reasonable). Why not eat a freshly cooked meal in our smart and comfortable restaurant, or play snooker (we have three well maintained tables) as well as pool or darts.

Every Saturday night we have live entertainment with music to suit all tastes and where you can dance the night away on our portable dance floor.

We are the only venue in Broadstone which offers Sky sports TV so all the big sporting events are covered.

Your Club membership allows you to benefit from all Club facilities which includes many other social events, and which are advertised on the Club Notice Board opposite Reception.

To join the Club you **must join the RBL** (the Charity) and the Club (see separate forms). This is because the RBL is a registered charity and the Broadstone RBL Club is a limited company (which is affiliated to the RBL) and by law the finances must be kept separate.

1. **To join the RBL** – complete the form with “**Live On**” at the top – an example is enclosed to help.

Payment can be made by either completing the Direct Debit form or by enclosing a cheque for **£19.00** (payable to RBL).

2. **To join the Club** – complete the form headed “**APPLICATION FOR MEMBERSHIP**”

The Proposer and Secunder **must** be Club members but if you don't know any, please put an “X” in the box.

The Cost (which includes a Joining fee and door entry card or fob) is **£17.00** which can either be paid by cash or cheque payable to Broadstone RBL Club Ltd.

Subsequent renewal payments of £11, payable on the anniversary of joining, can be by cash, cheque, bank transfer or, if wished, be set up by completing the Standing Order section which **must** be signed where applicable. When renewing, you must use your Club membership number as a reference for bank transfers and Standing Orders in order for us to reconcile the payments.

Data Protection. Please note that you are asked on the form for contact information. This may be used to advise you about your membership status and renewal date. We would also like to use it to advise you of Club information/ event updates but will not do so if you check the appropriate boxes. This information will not be passed to any third party unless we are legally required to do so.

When completed put both forms and cash/cheques in the large envelope and post it in the post-box on the wall behind the Reception Desk for checking and approval. Providing everything is in order your Application will be processed and your Broadstone Club Membership card, and door entry card/fob will be ready for collection from behind the bar in 2 – 3 weeks. Your RBL card will arrive by post separately some weeks later.
