Welcome to Broadstone RBL Club Ltd

Thank you for applying to become a Member of this prestigious Club. The Cost (which includes a Joining Fee and membership card) is **£17.00** which can either be paid by cash or cheque payable to Broadstone RBL Club Ltd.

Subsequent renewal payments of £11, payable on the anniversary of joining (which will be shown on your membership card), can be by cash, cheque, or bank transfer. When renewing, you must use your **Club membership number** as a reference for bank transfers.

This is in accordance with our GDPR statement which you can find on the reverse of the application form or on our website at www.broadstonelegion.co.uk/membership.html. Information will not be passed to any third party unless we are legally required to do so.

When completed put both forms and cash/cheques in the large envelope and deposit it in the post-box on the wall behind the Reception Desk for checking and approval. Providing everything is in order your Application will be processed and your Broadstone Club Membership card will be ready for collection from behind the bar in 2 – 3 weeks. Your RBL card will arrive by post separately in accordance with RBL timescales (which can be lengthy).
