AS PER THE NEW GOVERNMENT TIER SYSTEM ANNOUNCED ON THURSDAY, WE HAVE BEEN PLACED IN TIER 2 FROM DECEMBER 2nd.

Therefore, we sadly have to announce that the club will remain shut until Poole is moved into Tier 1.

Forthcoming AGM

Even though we continue to be closed, we have to still run the AGM in January 2021.

There are currently 2 options being considered:

1 – if we are in Tier 1 and open, then the AGM will be ticket only to restrict numbers in the club and a live broadcast, probably via Facebook so that all other members can join the meeting. Any voting that is required will thus be a mixture of email voting and hand voting.

2 – if we are still closed, then the AGM will be broadcast, probably via Facebook, with mail voting for all.

We will be looking for nominations to the following positions:

President: currently Len Bucknall

Vice-Chair: currently Colin Campbell who is temporarily performing in this role

Secretary: currently Mark Jefferson who is temporarily performing in this role

All 3 officers above are happy to continue and will be standing for election.

There are 4 other committee members which will require filling. Note that of the current committee, 3 (Donna Brown, Paul Oliver and Gordon Talbot) were elected last January and so will continue in post. Mark Aldridge, Lynn Burrard and Gary Slade who have all completed 2 years have offered to continue and will stand for election again.

President, Chair and Finance Officer will continue as now as they were appointed last January and it is a 2 year term.

Formal Notification of the AGM along with requests for nominations to the various positions will follow in December (after the next government Tier review).

Members will also be requested to submit questions in advance of the AGM.
